



You are eligible for these scholarships if you are a first-time freshman applying within the first year after high school graduation.

You do not need to apply for this scholarship, as it will automatically be applied to your student account. If qualified, you will be awarded the scholarship amount split per semester, renewable for eight consecutive semesters. To continue receiving this scholarship, you must complete 15 credit hours each semester or 30 hours each academic year.
