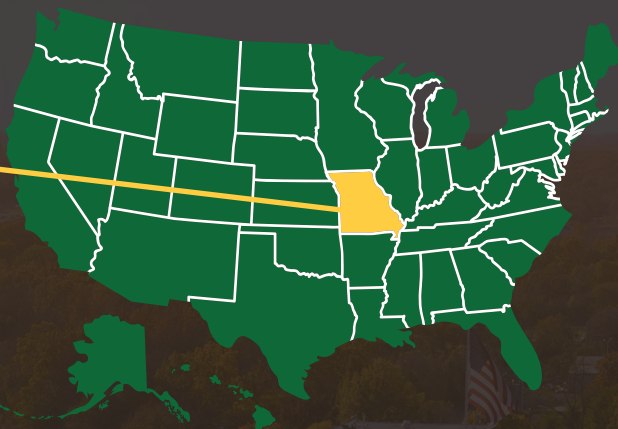


# WE HAVE WHAT YOU'RE LOOKING FOR

	Award Amount	Requirements
In-State + 10%	Tuition calculated at in-state rate + 10%	Must be transferring to MSSU with an Associate's degree from a partnership institution
Board of Governors Distinguished Scholarship	\$2,000* (per year)	Must be a degree-seeking student who has never attended MSSU, transferring at least 24 credit hours, and have a GPA of 3.50 or higher  *Renewable for six consecutive semesters
President's Distinguished Scholarship	\$1,500* (per year)	Must be a degree-seeking student who has never attended MSSU, transferring at least 24 credit hours, and has a GPA of 3.25 or higher  *Renewable for six consecutive semesters
Dean's Scholarship	\$500* (per year)	Must be a degree-seeking student who has never attended MSSU, transferring at least 24 credit hours, and has a GPA of 3.0 or higher  *Renewable for six consecutive semesters
Foundation Scholarships	Up to \$5,000	One application equals 300+ scholarship opportunities  Must have a valid I-20 and maintain a 2.5 GPA or higher

## ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

### TRANSFERS

**\*MUST MEET BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING**

- 2.0 cumulative GPA
- Be in good standing with previously attended college/university

## APPLICATION CHECKLIST

**Apply at [admissions.mssu.edu](https://admissions.mssu.edu) and complete the checklist below.**

\* Beginning in spring 2025, a \$3,000 enrollment deposit will be required upon obtaining a Visa (to be applied toward first and second-semester tuition)

### APPLY NOW

#### STEP 1

Submit a \$60 nonrefundable application fee (Must be paid before being accepted)

#### STEP 2

Request official college transcripts from previous institutions

#### STEP 3

Provide a copy of the identification page in your passport

#### STEP 4

Provide proof of finances, such as a bank statement showing enough funds to cover one year at MSSU
