3.7 GPA

10% of graduating class

or better on the ACT

TRANSFER STUDENTS, or CURRENT MSSU STUDENTS, must have a:

3.5 GPA

HONORS STUDENTS...

- Have the option to live in Lion Village in the Honors living-learning community
- Have monthly get-togethers
- Have access to their own lounge couches, chairs, laptop stations, and a private study room
- Have the opportunity to receive the Walter and Frederica Evans Scholarship (\$6,500 per academic year - \$3,250/ semester)
- Complete an international study experience
- Receive special recognition at Commencement, Honors designation on their diplomas and transcripts, and a certificate in Honors Interdisciplinary Studies
