HEALTH CENTER TESTING

All students are required to visit the Willcoxon Health Center before enrolling in classes at MSSU. You will be tested for TB and MMR, along with other tests as necessary. Once results are verified, you will be notified when you are able to enroll and attend classes.

PLACEMENT TESTING

All first-time freshmen who have not provided MSSU with an ACT or SAT score must take the ACT Residual test during Orientation. This is a requirement to determine math and English placement. The ACT Residual test is \$78, and you must pay for the test prior to the testing date you are given.

MICHIGAN ENGLISH TESTING

During Orientation, those students requiring this test will be given a test time, and you will be assigned an orientation leader to get you to the testing area. Once you receive your test results, you will meet with Aaron Carmichael to enroll in courses for the semester.

ENROLLMENT

Once cleared by the Willcoxon Health Center, you will be permitted to enroll. You will be assigned to an ambassador who will take you to an advisor to help you enroll in classes.

Please note: All incoming freshmen are required to enroll in UE 100, and your math and English course enrollment is based on your ACT, SAT, or ACT Residual scores.

TEXTBOOKS
